Minute from W A Gilchrist, Crown Office to Lord Advocate, 12 February 2003 – Dunblane Public Inquiry: access to records held by National Archives of Scotland. Exemption applicable under s.30(b)(i) and (ii).

Minute from Lindsey Anderson to Lord Advocate, 3 March 2003 – Dunblane Public Inquiry: disclosure of report by police officers to Procurators Fiscal. Exemption applicable under s.29(1)(a) and s.30(b)(i) and (ii).
